THE CONTEXT:

Millions of children are affected by disasters every year. The United Nations International Strategy for Disaster Reduction (UNISDR, 2011) advocated organized approaches to counter the effects of disasters. At this time of COVID 19, children are the biggest victims affected by the global pandemic. Evidences posit that a range of health and psychological risks engendered due to closures of school and children related services. Moreover, the impacts of harmful effects of COVID 19 are most damaging for children belonging to the marginalised sections who are already in the vulnerable situation. Children and their families are experiencing a range of ordeals due to the lockdown of the economy, closure of institutions meant for children and limited or no access to healthcare and other essential services required for children. The available evidence indicates the direct impact of COVID-19 on child and adolescent mortality to be very limited, but the indirect effects on child survival stemming from strained health systems, household income loss, and disruptions to care-seeking and preventative interventions like vaccination may be substantial and widespread across the world (UNISEF, 2020). In India, to contain the upcoming exigencies a proper training and capacity building related to Child Centric Disaster Risk Reduction is need of the hour.

COVID-19 has put a huge challenge in training and capacity building in terms of constraints related to social distancing. Training and awareness-building during new normal situations require an alternative and effective arrangement for timely COVID-19 response. Training at the time of pandemic is widely considered to be a powerful instrument for building the capacities of functionaries by enhancing and

upgrading their knowledge, skills and competencies on a regular and periodic basis. At this crucial time, training through online modules can be a liberator for building capacities of stakeholders serving the children directly or indirectly.

Keeping in view the increasing vulnerability of children to various disasters, Himachal Pradesh Institute of public Administration Fairlawn, Shimla & Himachal Pradesh State disaster Management Authority in collaboration with the **National Institute of Disaster Management** (Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India) is conducting an **Online Training Programme on 'Child Centric Disaster Risk Reduction'(CCDRR)** for the Central States during 12th to 14th October, 2020.

OBJECTIVES:

Main objective behind this three-day on-line training programme is:-

- ❖ To provide basic information on COVID-19 and emerging issues related to children's well-being
- ❖ To address the adverse impact of closures of Institutions, social distancing and lockdowns on children's education.
- ❖ To aware the participants about the Roles & Responsibilities of different Departments/Institutions/Organizations to combat with the COVID-19.
- ❖ To disseminate information on important concepts, guidelines, and policies issued by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), NIDM and State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA) from time to time regarding the Covid-19.

Outcomes of This Programme:

At the end of this online training programme participants will be able to: -

- ❖ Understand the process of CCDRR and its steps including mainstreaming different approaches.
- ❖ Comprehend an overview of the sectoral impacts of disaster on children.

- ❖ Provide an overview of CCDRR with an emphasis on Life Cycle Approaches Risk-Informed Programming.
- ❖ Understand the strategies to involve children in DRR activities.
- ❖ Provide basic information on COVID-19 and emerging issues related to children's well-being.
- ❖ Explain the different impacts of disaster on mental health of children.
- ❖ Address the School Safety Issues

Aims of the Programme:

This three-Day Online Training Programme on 'Child Centric Disaster Risk Reduction's aims to enhance the capacity of different service providers of children in various governmental and non-governmental organisation, Different Government Functionaries working in the particular fields, civil society practitioners, teachers, researcher and students to build their knowledge, skills and perspectives towards child-centric disaster risk reduction. This will help the stakeholders to understand and prepare for risk-informed planning, sectoral readiness and preparedness for emergencies so as children are not be deprived of basic amenities during disasters.

Target Group: -

Target audience for this training programme would be Officers/officials from Education, Health, Panchayati Raj, Rural Development, Revenue, Women and Child Welfare, Police Department, District Administration, and any other sectoral departments and NGOs of state working in the field of Disaster Risk Reduction.

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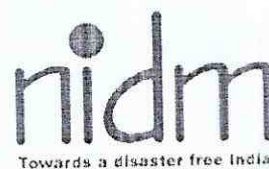
